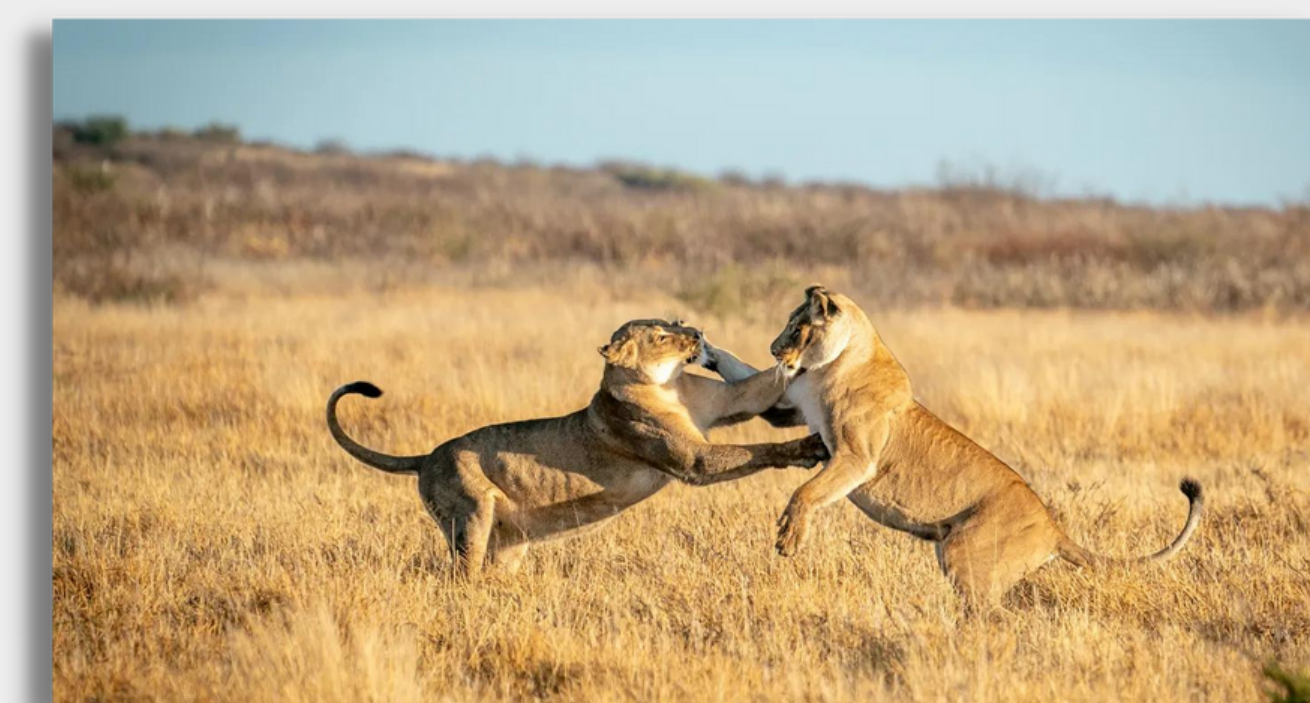

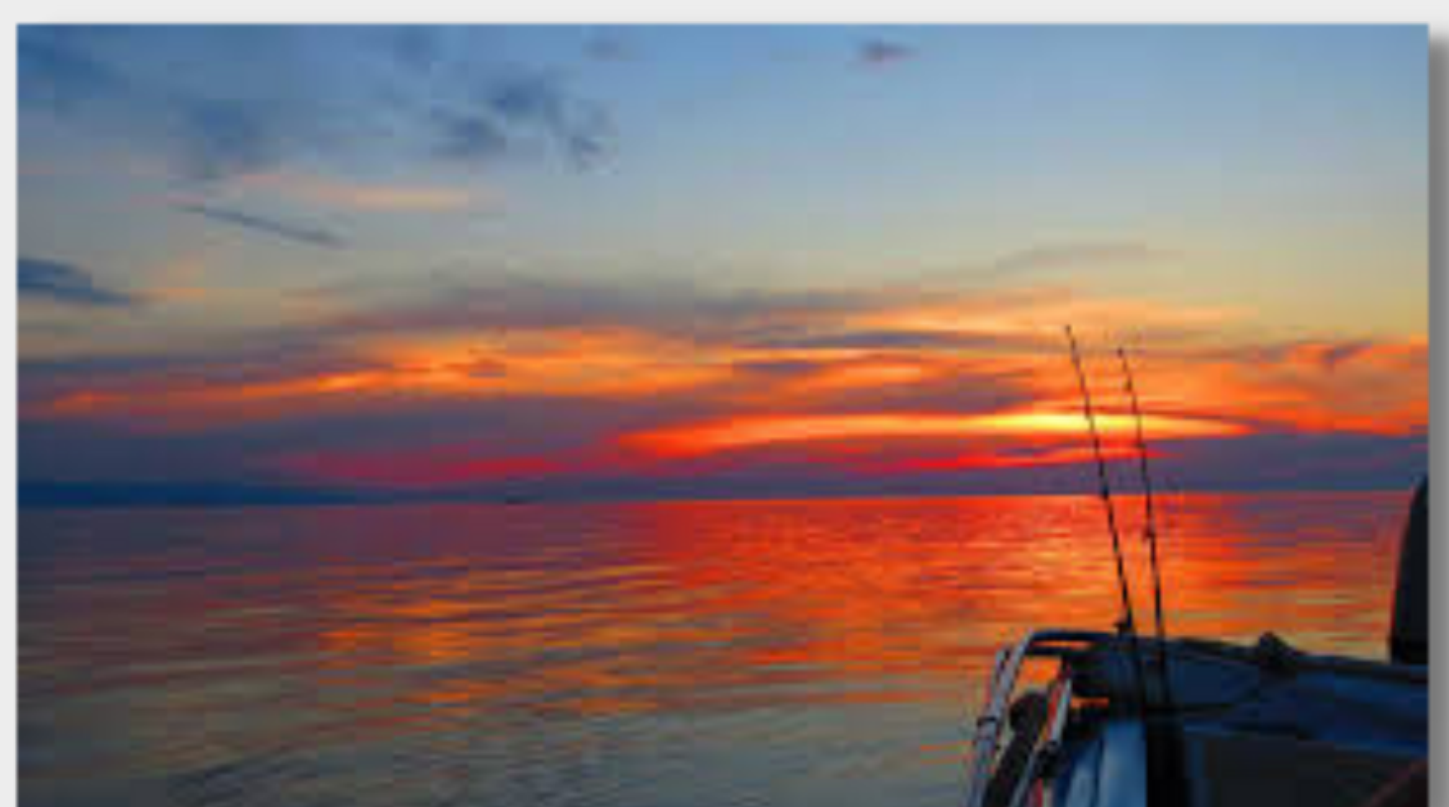


Day 2 & 3 Okavango Delta

Marvel at the migrating Zebra and Wildebeest during your morning flight over the Makgadikgadi Pans. Maun, a bustling bushplane hub, serves as your gateway to the Okavango Delta, an expansive maze of waterways brimming with wildlife. Over two days in the Okavango Camp, your knowledgeable guide unveils the secrets of the animal kingdom through 4x4 safaris, Makoro (dug-out canoe) excursions, and even on-foot encounters, making for riveting campfire tales.

Day 4 Victoria Falls

Soar over the Linyanti and Savuti areas, following the Chobe River to witness massive herds of elephants, hippos, and more. Transition into Zimbabwe, catching a glimpse of the iconic Victoria Falls from the air before landing at Vic Falls International. Explore the Falls from the ground and revel in the immersive experience.

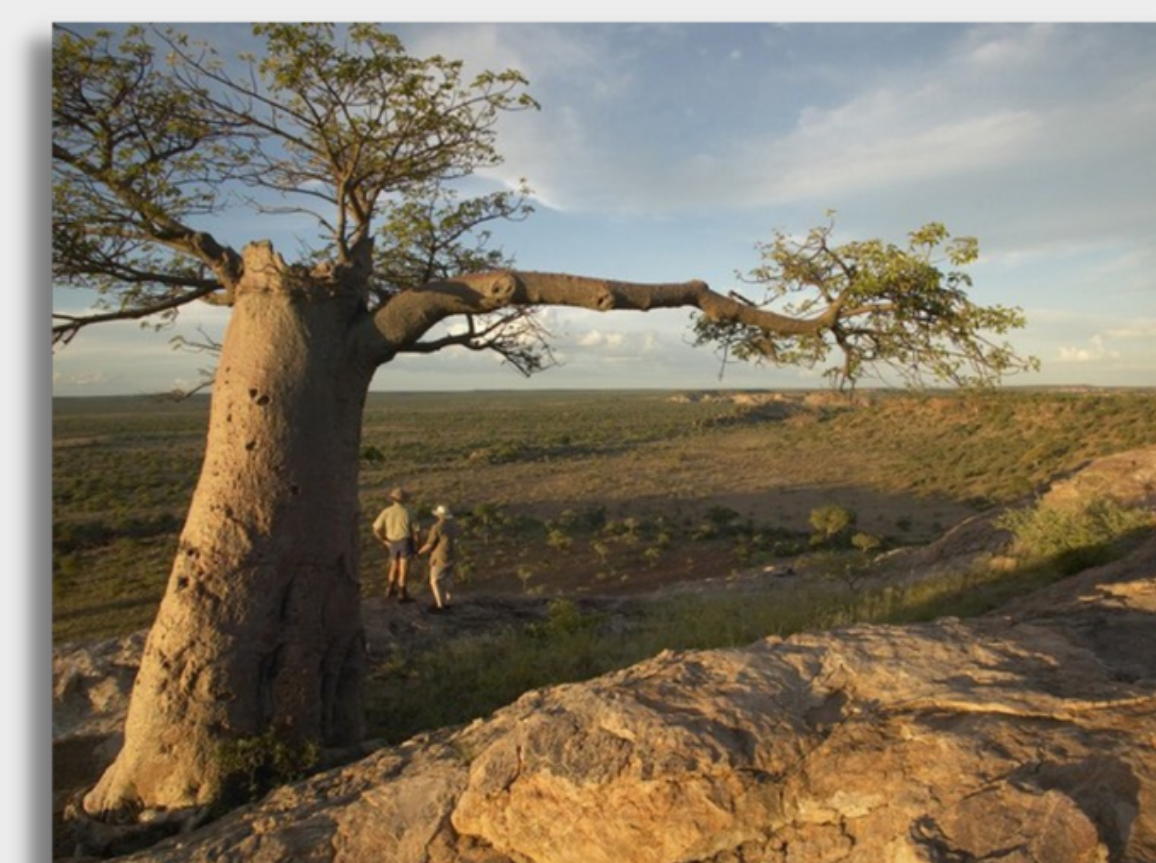


Day 5 & 6 Kariba
